## **Capturing Light in Your Still Life**

Have you ever struggled to get your paintings to look more real and three-dimensional? Do you ever end up with a muddy color on your brush and wonder what to do next?

In this still life course, we will focus on expressing light, shadow, half-tones, and atmosphere in the medium of oil paint. We will learn to make paintings that demonstrate an understanding of form and create the illusion of reality. Wherever you are in your painting journey, this will help you make progress.

Each session will begin with a demonstration. We will all work together on the same still life from different angles, so that design and lighting are already settled. This will leave students with the time to carefully observe and paint what the eye sees. We will spend 3 sessions on each set up before we move on to the next.

Through in-class exercises and critiques, as well as optional homework, students will chart a path to continue to grow as a studio painter.
